## VISION 2022-2025



To raise the number of international information exchanges through Prüm, Europol, INTERPOL and SIRENE police cooperation mechanisms, principally in the field of organized crime and terrorism.

To promote and encourage the participation and collaboration in international forensic projects, strategic twinning, technical assistances and peace missions.

To increase the presence in forensic working groups and international organisms (ENFSI, AICEF, INTERPOL, etc.).

To develop an analysis system and to exploit time real information that turns into forensic intelligence.



**EURODAC**

- European fingerprint database to identify irregular asylum and migration seekers who crossed the border.
- More than 400,000 reviews since 2018.

**PRÜM**

- Since the 27th of May 2005.
- Daily DNI and fingerprint profile exchanges with 23 countries.
- Next Generation Prüm will automatically exchange facial images.

**INTERPOL**

- 6 forensic databases (IBIN, I-family, facial recognition, DNA, fingerprints and victims identification).
